HOW TO CELEBRATE IN CHICAGO

- CHICAGO PRIDE PARADE: JUNE 25TH. THE ANNAUL PARADE, WHICH STARTED AS A PROTEST MARCH IN 1970 AFTER THE STONEWALL RIOTS IN NEW YORK CITY, HAS GROWN INTO THE CITY'S SECOND-LARGEST PARADE OF NEARLY 200 ENTRIES, TYPICALLY ATTRACTING MORE THAN 1 MILLION PEOPLE TO MULTIPLE NORTHSIDE NEIGHBORHOODS, PARTICULARLY EAST LAKEVIEW.
- CHICAGO PRIDE FEST: JUNE 17TH AND 18TH. THE 2-DAY STREET FESTIVAL IN THE NORTHALSTED NEIGHBORHOOD FEATURES LIVE MUSIC ON 3 STAGES, A YOUTH PRIDE SPACE FOR TEENS, BEST OF CHICAGO DRAG PERFORMANCE, PROUD PET PARADE, DANCE EXHIBITIONS, CHICAGO GAY MEN'S CHORUS, HIGH HEEL RACE FOR PRIZES, GUEST SPEAKERS AND OVER 150 FOOD AND MERCHANDISE VENDORS.
