Known as the "Ellis Island of the South" due to its use as the Cuban Assistance Center which provided aid to those seeking asylum from Castro's Cuba.

#### Salinas Pueblo Missions National Monument

These sites continue to stand as reminders of the Spanish and Pueblo peoples' early encounters and prompt exploration of today's interactions among different people.

#### San Juan National Historic Site

Oldest European construction in the U.S. and site of multiple battles against the Dutch and British.
